

WEAR SAFETY GLASSES

Foresight is better than no sight. During operation, any power tool can throw foreign objects and harmful chemicals into your eyes. Always put on safety glasses or eye shields before starting up the Turning Center. Safety glasses or shields should provide full protection at the sides, as well as the front of the eyes.

KNOW YOUR MACHINE TOOL

Keep the Turning Center User's Guide readily accessible for quick reference. Know the intended applications and limitations of the Turning Center as well as its hazards.

KEEP THE SAFETY SHIELD IN PLACE

The safety shield should remain in place whenever the spindle motor is on or the cross slide is moving.

REMOVE ADJUSTING KEYS AND WRENCHES

Make it a habit to check that keys and adjusting wrenches are removed from the Turning Center before turning on the machine.

KEEP THE WORK AREA CLEAN

Cluttered work areas and bench tops invite accidents.

KEEP UNTRAINED VISITORS AWAY FROM THE EQUIPMENT

Children and visitors unfamiliar with the hazards of rotating machinery should always be kept away from the work area.

PREVENT UNAUTHORIZED USERS FROM OPERATING THE TURNING CENTER

Lock and remove the key from the Turning Center Controller Box when the system is not in use.

**DO NOT FORCE A TOOL**

Select the feed rate and depth of cut best suited to the design, construction and purpose of the cutting tool. It is always better to take too light a cut than too heavy a cut.

USE THE RIGHT TOOL

Select the type of cutting tool best suited to the lathe operation. Don't force a tool or attachment to do a job it wasn't designed to do.

DRESS APPROPRIATELY

Don't wear loose clothing or jewelry which can get caught in moving parts. Wear a hat or hair net, or tie your hair back to keep it away from moving parts.

SECURE THE WORKPIECE

Be certain that you have firmly secured the work piece and the cutting tool before turning on the spindle motor.

DO NOT OVERREACH

Keep your footing and balance at all times so you won't fall into or grab the moving machine.

MAINTAIN CUTTING TOOLS IN TOP CONDITION

Keep cutting tools sharp and clean. Lubricate and clean Turning Center components on a regular basis.

DISCONNECT TOOLS BEFORE SERVICING

Always use the emergency stop switch to disconnect power and disable the spindle motor before mounting or removing the work piece, or changing tools. Do not rely solely on a programmed Pause command to disable Turning Center operation.

AVOID ACCIDENTAL STARTING

Make sure the power switch on the controller box is off before plugging in the power cord.

USE RECOMMENDED ACCESSORIES

To avoid stressing the Turning Center and creating a hazardous machining environment, use only those accessories designed for use with the Turning Center, available through Light Machines Corporation.

TIGHTEN ALL HOLDING, LOCKING AND DRIVING DEVICES

Tighten the chuck. Do not over tighten tool holding devices. Over tightening may damage threads or warp parts, thereby reducing accuracy and effectiveness.

KEEP COOLANT AWAY FROM ELECTRICAL COMPONENTS

Do not allow coolant to splash into or near the computer.

DO NOT OPERATE THE MACHINE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF MEDICINE

Medicine may impair your judgment and reaction time, which could contribute to an on-the-job accident.

AVOID DISTRACTIONS WHILE RUNNING THE MACHINE

Use simple common sense and pay attention while operating any piece of machinery.

USING DESKTOP COMPUTERS / LAPTOPS / PRINTERS/ PLOTTERS

If the category is dealing with desktop computers, printers/plotters and a number of design tools. To ensure your personal safety, do the following:

BEFORE THE COMPETITION STARTS

Read the competition Health and Safety Regulations' manual and be familiar with the safety rules and instructions with regards to machine safety, electrical safety and other requirements for personal protective safety equipment.

DURING THE COMPETITION

- Make sure that no working materials interface with the adjacent competitor's and that your actions don't obstruct his/her work.
- Leave sufficient space for other persons/competitors when using the same machine.
- Keep all passages free of litter and unnecessary items.
- Keep your work area clean and tidy.
- Follow the safety precautions related to the tools/machines you are using during the competition.
- No drinks are allowed while working on the computer.



DRESS CODE

Only female students are allowed to wear the traditional dress. For male students uniform policy is strictly enforced.

Purpose:

The purpose of the dress code policy is that all the participants maintain the respect of UAE social and cultural values.

EmiratesSkills is under a professional educational environment and this fact should be reinforced through the professional appearance of all participants to the competition.

EmiratesSkills requires all competitors to be aware of their appearance and in addition to being particular with their own personal hygiene. All participants must dress appropriately to maintain decorum contributing to an atmosphere of high standard of professionalism.




DIRECTIONS BY CAR

Directions from Abu Dhabi's Corniche:

Khaleej Al Arabi Street (also known as Coast Road/30th Street) and Rashid Bin Saeed Al Maktoum St (also known as Airport Road) are the two main highways that link Abu Dhabi City Centre / Corniche with ADNEC.

Directions via Rashid Bin Saeed Al Maktoum Street (Airport Road):

Travel along Airport Road from the Corniche (heading out of Abu Dhabi) until you reach the cross street numbered 29. Go over this street and take the next exit off to the right towards 'East Road' and 'Coast Road'. At the roundabout take the first exit. Pick up signs to the exhibition centre and follow directions to the adjacent multi-storey car parks.

Directions via Khaleej Al Arabi Street:

Travel along Khaleej Al Arabi Street from the Corniche (heading out of Abu Dhabi) until you pass the iconic Capital Gate tower and exhibition centre on your left hand side. As you pass ADNEC you need to move into the right hand lane and take the next exit signed towards 'Corniche' and 'Rashid Bin Saeed Al Maktoum Street'. Pick up signs to the exhibition centre and follow directions to the adjacent multi-storey car parks.

From Dubai:

The journey from to ADNEC from Jebel Ali, Dubai should take no more than 45 minutes. Leave Dubai on the Sheikh Zayed Road (E11), following the signs for Abu Dhabi/ Jebel Ali. As you leave the emirate of Dubai and enter the emirate of Abu Dhabi the name of the road changes to the Sheikh Maktoum Bin Rashid Road. You stay on this road for approximately 30 minutes, passing Al Raha Mall on your right and the 'coin-shaped' HQ building. About 5 minutes after passing the mall move to the right hand lane. Exit the Sheikh Maktoum Bin Rashid Road, following the signs for Abu Dhabi (E22). Stay in the right hand lane and continue to follow the signs for Abu Dhabi (E22). Once on the E22, continue over Al Maqtaa Bridge, at this point the iconic Sheikh Zayed Mosque should be on your left. You will now be on Airport Road, continue along for 2km until you reach a set of traffic lights (a park will be on your left hand side). Continue straight passing an ADNOC petrol station on your right, and a Carrefour supermarket on your left side. Take the immediate exit to the right after the supermarket, following the signs to the exhibition centre. At the roundabout take the fourth exit and follow signs to the adjacent multi-storey car parks.

From Al Ain:

Head out of Al Ain on E22 following signs to Abu Dhabi, use Mussafah Bridge to cross onto the island. You will be on Khaleej Al Arabi Street, continue past Sheikh Zayed Mosque and Zayed Sports City on your right hand side and pick up signs for the Exhibition Centre. Follow the signs to the exhibition centre and directions to the adjacent multi-storey car parks.



PRAYER FACILITIES IN THE VENUE

ADNEC has designated Male and Female prayer rooms with washing facilities.

The Prayer Rooms are located on Level 1, near the Business Centre and on Level 1 by the Aloft Hotel.




